A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to reauthorize migrant, community and homeless health center programs, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Health Centers Reau-
5 thorization Act of 1994”.

6 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF CERTAIN HEALTH CENTER**
7 **PROGRAMS.**

8 (a) MIGRANT HEALTH CENTERS.—Section
9 329(h)(2)(A) of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C.

1 254b(h)(2)(A) is amended by striking “1994” and insert-
2 ing “1995”.

3 (b) COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTERS.—Section 330(g)
4 of such Act (42 U.S.C. 254c(g)) is amended—

5 (1) in paragraph (1)(A), by striking “1994”
6 and inserting “1995”; and

7 (2) in paragraph (2)(A), by striking “1994”
8 and inserting “1995”.

9 (c) HOMELESS HEALTH SERVICES.—Section
10 340(q)(1) of such Act (42 U.S.C. 256(q)(1)) is amended
11 by striking “1994” and inserting “1995”.

12 (d) PUBLIC HOUSING HEALTH SERVICES.—Section
13 340A(p)(1) of such Act (42 U.S.C. 256a(p)(1)) is amend-
14 ed by striking “and 1993” and inserting “through 1995”.
