A BILL

For the relief of Nguyen Quy An and his daughter, Nguyen Ngoc Kim Quy.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
5 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
6 1101 et seq.), Nguyen Quy An and his daughter, Nguyen
7 Ngoc Kim Quy, shall be held and considered to have been
8 lawfully admitted to the United States for permanent resi-
9 dence as of the date of the enactment of this Act upon
10 payment of the required visa fees.

1 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

2 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Nguyen
3 Quy An and his daughter, Nguyen Ngoc Kim Quy, as pro-
4 vided in this Act, the Secretary of State shall instruct the
5 proper officer to reduce by two numbers during the cur-
6 rent fiscal year the total number of immigrant visas avail-
7 able to natives of the country of the alien's birth under
8 section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8
9 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
