## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on nickel isoindoline pigment.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NICKEL ISOINDOLINE PIGMENT.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7 new heading:

“	9902.32.31	Nickel isoindoline pigment (CAS No. 85958-80-1) (provided for in subheading 3204.17.30) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/97	”.
