To require the Secretary of Agriculture to submit monthly financial obligation and employment reports to Congress for the Food Safety and Inspection Service, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MONTHLY FINANCIAL OBLIGATION AND EM-**
4 **PLOYMENT REPORTS FOR FOOD SAFETY AND**
5 **INSPECTION SERVICE.**

6 The Secretary of Agriculture shall, by the 15th day
7 of each month, submit a report to the Committees on Agri-

1 culture and Appropriations of the House of Representa-
2 tives and the Committees on Agriculture, Nutrition, and
3 Forestry and Appropriations of the Senate setting forth
4 an analysis by the Secretary of the financial obligations
5 and employment status during the second preceding
6 month for the Food Safety and Inspection Service, includ-
7 ing—

8 (1) the cumulative total cost for the fiscal year;

9 (2) the number of unfilled requirements for in-
10 spectors appointed to carry out the programs of the
11 Service; and

12 (3) the number of inspectors required to inspect
13 establishments under the authority of the programs.
