Mr. HATCH (for himself and Mr. BENNETT) introduced the following bill;
which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Nat-
ural Resources

A BILL

To reduce the restrictions on lands conveyed by deed under
the Act of June 8, 1926.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That section 2 of the Act of June 8, 1926 (ch. 498; 44
4 Stat. 708), is amended by striking “States” at the end
5 of the first sentence and inserting in lieu thereof the fol-
6 lowing: “States, except that these restrictions on convey-
7 ances and uses shall not apply to those lands upon which
8 communications facilities were located as of January 1,
9 1993, or prevent reasonable ingress and egress for the re-
10 pair, maintenance, expansion, or improvement of such fa-

1 cilities, nor shall these restrictions on conveyances and
2 uses prohibit the use of the lands described in the first
3 section of this Act for recreational purposes so long as
4 such recreational use is consistent both with the protection
5 of the watershed and water supply system of the City and
6 with the management objectives for adjacent National
7 Forest System lands”.
