Mr. PELL (by request) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

A BILL

To authorize appropriations for the African Development Foundation.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. Section 505 of title V of the International
4 Security and Development Cooperation Act of 1980 is
5 amended by adding subsection (c) to read as follows:

6 “(c) When, with the permission of the Foundation,
7 funds made available to a grantee under this title are in-
8 vested pending disbursement, the resulting interest is not
9 required to be deposited in the United States Treasury
10 if the grantee uses the resulting interest for the purposes
11 for which the grant was made. This subsection applies

1 with respect to both interest earned before and interest
2 earned after the enactment of this subsection.”.

3 SEC. 2. Section 506(a) of title V is amended by add-
4 ing paragraph (13) to read as follows:

5 “(13) When determined by the president of the
6 African Development Foundation to be necessary,
7 and subject to such security investigations as the
8 Foundation may determine to be appropriate, may
9 employ persons who are not citizens of the United
10 States without regard to statutory provisions prohib-
11 iting payment of compensation to persons who are
12 not citizens of the United States or to statutory pro-
13 visions relating to employment in the competitive
14 service; provided, that this paragraph shall pertain
15 only to individuals under negotiated contracts with
16 the Foundation as of October 6, 1992.”.

17 SEC. 3. Section 507(b) is amended by deleting “ac-
18 tual and necessary expenses not exceeding \$100 per day,
19 and for transportation expenses” and inserting “necessary
20 travel expenses in accordance with subchapter I of chapter
21 57, title 5, United States Code,” in lieu thereof.

22 SEC. 4. Section 510 of title V is amended by deleting
23 “\$3,872,000 for fiscal year 1986, and \$3,872,000 for fis-
24 cal year 1987” in the first sentence, and inserting

1 “\$16,905,000 for fiscal year 1994, and \$17,393,000 for
2 fiscal year 1995.”
