## A BILL

To provide for a 1-year delay in the applicability of certain regulations to certain municipal solid waste landfills under the Solid Waste Disposal Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Municipal Solid Waste  
5 Landfill Regulatory Extension Act of 1993”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXEMPTION OF CERTAIN LANDFILLS FROM MEET-**  
2 **ING REVISED CRITERIA.**

3 (a) EXEMPTION.—During the 1-year period begin-  
4 ning on October 9, 1993, each municipal solid waste land-  
5 fill that—

6 (1) is in existence on October 8, 1993; and

7 (2) meets the requirements of the criteria con-  
8 tained in regulations issued pursuant to sections  
9 4004(a) and 4010(c) of the Solid Waste Disposal  
10 Act (42 U.S.C. 6944(a) and 6949a(c), respectively)  
11 as in effect on January 1, 1993,

12 shall not be required to meet any revised criteria that take  
13 effect after the date specified in paragraph (2).

14 (b) PRIOR CRITERIA APPLICABLE DURING EXEMP-  
15 TION PERIOD.—During the period specified in subsection  
16 (a), a landfill referred to in such subsection shall be sub-  
17 ject to the criteria referred to in paragraph (2) of such  
18 subsection.

19 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE OF REVISED CRITERIA.—Be-  
20 ginning on October 9, 1994, each municipal solid waste  
21 landfill shall be subject to the revised criteria applicable  
22 to the landfill issued pursuant to sections 4004(a) and  
23 4010(c) of the Solid Waste Disposal Act (42 U.S.C.  
24 6944(a) and 6949a(c), respectively), and any subsequent  
25 revision to the criteria.
