Mr. FORD (for Mr. MITCHELL) submitted the following concurrent resolution;
which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To authorize the reprinting of the book entitled “The United
States Capitol: A Brief Architectural History”.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That there shall be printed as a Senate docu-
3 ment, the book entitled “The United States Capitol: A
4 Brief Architectural History”, prepared by the Office of the
5 Architect of the Capitol.

6 SEC. 2. Such document shall include illustrations,
7 and shall be in such style, form, manner, and binding as
8 directed by the Joint Committee on Printing after con-
9 sultation with the Secretary of the Senate.

1 SEC. 3. In addition to the usual number of copies,
2 there shall be printed—

3 (1) 56,500 copies for the use of the Commission
4 on the Bicentennial of the United States Capitol; or

5 (2) such number of copies as does not exceed
6 a total production and printing cost of \$69,206.
