To authorize expenditures for the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources for the period March 1, 1993, through February 28, 1995.

IN THE SENATE OF THE UNITED STATES

Mr. JOHNSTON, (from the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources), reported the following original resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules and Administration

RESOLUTION

To authorize expenditures for the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources for the period March 1, 1993, through February 28, 1995.

1 *Resolved*, That, in carrying out its powers, duties, and
2 functions under the Standing Rules of the Senate, in ac-
3 cordance with its jurisdiction under rule XXV of such
4 rules, including holding hearings, reporting such hearings,
5 and making investigations as authorized by paragraphs 1
6 and 8 of rule XXVI of the Standing Rules of the Senate,
7 the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources is au-
8 thorized from March 1, 1993, through February 28, 1994,
9 and March 1, 1994, through February 28, 1995, in its

1 discretion (1) to make expenditures from the contingent
2 fund of the Senate, (2) to employ personnel, and (3) with
3 the prior consent of the Government department or agency
4 concerned and the Committee on Rules and Administra-
5 tion, to use on a reimbursable or nonreimbursable basis
6 the services of personnel of any such department or
7 agency.

8 SEC. 2. The expenses of the committee for the period
9 March 1, 1993, through February 28, 1994, under this
10 resolution shall not exceed \$2,938,002.

11 (b) For the period March 1, 1994, through February
12 28, 1995, expenses of the committee under this resolution
13 shall not exceed \$3,000,982.

14 SEC. 3. The committee shall report its findings, to-
15 gether with such recommendations for legislation as it
16 deems advisable, to the Senate at the earliest practicable
17 date, but not later than February 28, 1994, and February
18 28, 1995, respectively.

19 SEC. 4. Expenses of the committee under this resolu-
20 tion shall be paid from the contingent fund of the Senate
21 upon vouchers approved by the chairman of the commit-
22 tee, except that vouchers shall not be required (1) for the
23 disbursement of salaries of employees paid at an annual
24 rate, or (2) for the payment of telecommunications pro-
25 vided by the Office of the Sergeant at Arms and Door-

1 keeper, United States Senate, or (3) for the payment of
2 stationery supplies purchased through the Keeper of the
3 Stationery, United States Senate, or (4) for payments to
4 the Postmaster, United States Senate, or (5) for the pay-
5 ment of metered charges on copying equipment provided
6 by the Office of the Sergeant at Arms and Doorkeeper,
7 United States Senate, or (6) for the payment of Senate
8 Recording and Photographic Services.

9 SEC. 5. There are authorized such sums as may be
10 necessary for agency contributions related to the com-
11 pensation of employees of the committee from March 1,
12 1993, through February 28, 1994, and March 1, 1994,
13 through February 28, 1995, to be paid from the Appro-
14 priations account for "Expenses of Inquiries and Inves-
15 tigations."

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
