A BILL

To prohibit award, grant, and contract recipients from lobbying for the continuation of their awards, grants, and contracts and to repeal authority for the payment of expenses of intervening and the payment of attorney's fees, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Integrity in Govern-
5 ment Act".

1 **SEC. 2. LOBBYING FOR AWARDS, GRANTS, AND CONTRACTS.**

2 No recipient of an award, grant, or contract from the
3 Federal Government may engage in, or have others engage
4 in, lobbying for—

5 (1) the continuation of the award, grant, or
6 contract,

7 (2) the program under which the award, grant,
8 or contract was made, or

9 (3) the continued funding of any program with-
10 in, or, the department or agency administering, such
11 program.

12 For purposes of this section, the term “lobbying” means
13 lobbying contacts and efforts in support of such contacts,
14 including preparation and planning activities and research
15 and other background work that is intended, at the time
16 it is performed, for use in contacts and coordination with
17 the lobbying activities of others.

18 **SEC. 3. PAYMENTS.**

19 Any payment of a fine, penalty, or settlement re-
20 quired of a corporation as a result of a judicial action,
21 threatened judicial action, or consent decree based on a
22 violation of a Federal regulation shall be paid only to the
23 United States Treasury.

24 **SEC. 4. EXEMPT ORGANIZATIONS.**

25 An organization described in section 501(c)(4) of the
26 Internal Revenue Code of 1986 shall not be eligible for

1 the receipt of Federal funds in the form of an award,
2 grant, contract, or loan or in any other form.

3 **SEC. 5. NATIONAL EDUCATION ASSOCIATION FEDERAL**
4 **CHARTER.**

5 The Act of June 30, 1906 (34 Stat. 804) is repealed.

6 **SEC. 6. INTERVENTION EXPENSES.**
