Mr. McCOLLUM introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To improve the capability to analyze deoxyribonucleic acid.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “DNA Identification
5 Grants Improvement Act of 1995”.

6 **SEC. 2. DNA IDENTIFICATION GRANTS.**

7 Section 1001(a) of the Omnibus Crime Control and
8 Safe Streets Act is amended by striking paragraph (22)
9 and inserting the following:

10 “(22) There are authorized to be appropriated
11 to carry out part X—

12 “(A) \$8,000,000 for fiscal year 1996;

1 “(B) \$12,000,000 for fiscal year 1997;

2 “(C) \$10,000,000 for fiscal year 1998;

3 “(D) \$6,000,000 for fiscal year 1999; and

4 “(E) \$4,000,000 for fiscal year 2000.”.

5 **SEC. 3. ADVISORY BOARD AND DNA INDEX.**

6 Section 210306 of the Violent Crime Control and
7 Law Enforcement Act of 1994 is amended by striking
8 paragraphs (1) through (5) and inserting the following:

9 “(1) \$4,000,000 for fiscal year 1996;

10 “(2) \$4,500,000 for fiscal year 1997;

11 “(3) \$5,000,000 for fiscal year 1998;

12 “(4) \$5,500,000 for fiscal year 1999; and

13 “(5) \$6,000,000 for fiscal year 2000.”.
