A BILL

To amend the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1990 to clarify that the expenses of administering the Old Age, Survivors and Disability Insurance programs are not included in the budget of the United States Government, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. CLARIFICATION OF STATUS OF ADMINISTRA-**
2 **TIVE EXPENSES PAID FROM THE OASDI**
3 **TRUST FUNDS.**

4 (a) Section 13301(a) of the Omnibus Budget Rec-
5 onciliation Act of 1990 is amended by inserting “(includ-
6 ing the expenses of administering the old-age, survivors,
7 and disability insurance programs)” before “shall” and by
8 adding at the end the following new sentence: “No ex-
9 penses of administering the old-age, survivors, and disabil-
10 ity insurance programs shall be subject to sequestration
11 under the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Con-
12 trol Act of 1985.”.

13 (b)(1) Section 250(c)(4)(B) of the Balanced Budget
14 and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 is amended
15 by inserting after “appropriations” the following: “, except
16 that expenses for the administration of the social security
17 old-age and survivors insurance trust fund and the disabil-
18 ity insurance trust fund (20–8006–0–7–651 and 20–
19 8007–0–7–651) shall not be considered to be within any
20 category”.

21 (2) Section 253(b) of such Act is amended by striking
22 “and” after paragraph (2), by striking the period and in-
23 serting “; and” after paragraph (3), and by adding at the
24 end the following new paragraph:

25 “(4) any spending excluded under section
26 250(c)(4)(B).”.

1 (3) Section 256(h)(4) of such Act is amended by in-
2 serting at the end the following:

3 “(J) The old-age, survivors and disability
4 insurance (OASDI) programs.”.

5 **SEC. 2. PROTECTION OF THE OASDI TRUST FUNDS IN THE**
6 **HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.**

7 (a) CONTENT OF CONCURRENT RESOLUTION ON THE
8 BUDGET.—The last sentence of section 301(a) of the Con-
9 gressional Budget Act of 1974 is amended by inserting
10 before the period the following: “, but shall separately set
11 forth an estimate of benefit payments under the old-age,
12 survivors, and disability insurance programs under title II
13 of the Social Security Act for the fiscal year and each of
14 the two ensuing fiscal years”.

15 (b) PROTECTION OF OASDI TRUST FUNDS.—Sec-
16 tion 13302 of the Budget Enforcement Act of 1990 is
17 amended by inserting at the end the following:

18 “(d) POINT OF ORDER.—It shall not be in order in
19 the House of Representatives to consider any bill or joint
20 resolution, as reported, amendment, or conference report
21 the enactment of which would provide an appropriation
22 for a fiscal year for the expenses of administering the old-
23 age, survivors, and disability insurance programs under
24 title II of the Social Security Act in excess of 1.5 percent
25 of the estimate of benefit payments under those programs

1 for that fiscal year set forth in the most recently agreed
2 to concurrent resolution on the budget.”.

3 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

4 The amendments made by this Act shall apply to fis-
5 cal year 1996 and subsequent fiscal years.
