3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON LAND ACQUISITION: MISSOURI**
4 **RIVER, NEBRASKA AND SOUTH DAKOTA.**

5 The undesignated paragraph in section 3(a) of the
6 Wild and Scenic Rivers Act (16 U.S.C. 1274(a)) relating
7 to the 39-mile segment of the Missouri River, Nebraska
8 and South Dakota, from the headwaters of Lewis and

1 Clark Lake to Ft. Randall Dam is amended by adding
2 at the end the following: “Notwithstanding section 6(a),
3 lands and interests in lands may not be acquired for the
4 purposes of this paragraph without the consent of the
5 owner thereof.”.
