Mrs. SCHROEDER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To authorize appropriations to develop technologies that can be used to combat terrorism, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Counterterrorism
5 Technology Research Act of 1995”.

6 **SEC. 2. RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT TO SUPPORT**
7 **COUNTERTERRORISM TECHNOLOGIES.**

8 There are authorized to be appropriated not to exceed
9 \$20,000,000 to the National Institute of Justice Science
10 and Technology Office in the Department of Justice—

1 (1) to develop technologies that can be used to
2 combat terrorism, including technologies in the areas
3 of—

4 (A) detection of weapons, explosives,
5 chemicals, and persons;

6 (B) tracking;

7 (C) surveillance;

8 (D) vulnerability assessment; and

9 (E) information technologies;

10 (2) to develop standards to ensure the adequacy
11 of products produced and compatibility with relevant
12 national systems; and

13 (3) to identify and assess requirements for tech-
14 nologies to assist State and local law enforcement in
15 the national program to combat terrorism.
