A BILL

To amend the Doug Barnard, Jr.—1996 Atlanta Centennial Olympic Games Commemorative Coin Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CHANGES IN COIN SPECIFICATIONS.**

4 Section 102 of the Doug Barnard, Jr.—1996 Atlanta
5 Centennial Olympic Games Commemorative Coin Act (91
6 U.S.C. 5112 note) is amended—

7 (1) in the table at the end of subsection (a)—

1 (A) by striking “Not more than 175,000
2 each of 2 coins of different designs” and insert-
3 ing “2 coins of different designs, in quantities
4 not to exceed 175,000 of each design”; and

5 (B) by striking “Not more than 300,000
6 each of 2 coins of different designs” and insert-
7 ing “2 coins of different designs, in quantities
8 not to exceed 100,000 of the first design and
9 not to exceed 150,000 of the second design”;

10 (2) in the table at the end of subsection (b)—

11 (A) by striking “Not more than 750,000
12 each of 4 coins of different designs” and insert-
13 ing “4 coins of different designs, in quantities
14 not to exceed 750,000 of each design”; and

15 (B) by striking “Not more than 1,000,000
16 each of 4 coins of different designs” and insert-
17 ing “4 coins of different designs, in quantities
18 not to exceed 350,000 of each of the first 2 de-
19 signs, and not to exceed 500,000 of each of the
20 remaining 2 designs”; and

21 (3) by striking subsection (c) and inserting the
22 following:

23 “(c) HALF DOLLAR CLAD COINS.—

1 “(1) SPECIFICATIONS.—The Secretary shall
2 issue not more than 8,000,000 half dollar coins,
3 each of which shall—

4 “(A) weigh 11.34 grams;

5 “(B) have a diameter of 30.61 millimeters;

6 “(C) be minted to the specifications for
7 half dollar coins under section 5112(b) of title
8 31, United States Code; and

9 “(D) contain an inscription of the year
10 ‘1995’ or ‘1996’, as the Secretary determines to
11 be appropriate.

12 “(2) DESIGNS.—Coins issued under paragraph
13 (1) shall be of 4 designs selected in accordance with
14 this Act in such quantities as the Secretary deter-
15 mines to be appropriate.”.
