1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. COMMENCEMENT DATE OF TEMPORARY**
4 **JUDGESHIPS.**

5 Section 203(c) of the Judicial Improvements Act of
6 1990 (Public Law 101-650; 104 Stat. 5101; 28 U.S.C.

1 133 note) is amended by striking out the last sentence
2 and inserting in lieu thereof “The first vacancy in the of-
3 fice of district judge in each of the judicial districts named
4 in this subsection, except the western district of Michigan,
5 occurring 5 years or more after the confirmation date of
6 the judge named to fill a temporary judgeship created by
7 this Act, shall not be filled. The first vacancy in the office
8 of district judge in the western district of Michigan, occur-
9 ring after December 1, 1995, shall not be filled.”.
