A BILL

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. CORPS OF ENGINEERS OVERSIGHT OF**
2 **SUPERFUND CONTRACTS.**

3 Section 104 of the Comprehensive Environmental Re-
4 sponse, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980 is
5 amended by adding the following at the end thereof.

6 “(k) CORPS OF ENGINEERS OVERSIGHT OF
7 SUPERFUND CONTRACTS.—Except in the case of remedial
8 actions carried out by a State or political subdivision
9 under subsection (d), contract administration of awarded
10 contracts for design and construction associated with
11 Fund lead remedial actions commenced under this section
12 after the date of enactment of this subsection shall be per-
13 formed by the United States Army Corps of Engineers.
14 Nothing in this subsection shall be interpreted to affect
15 existing contracts or procedures for awarding any con-
16 tracts under this Act.”
