To designate a United States courthouse in Scranton, Penn-
sylvania, as the “William J. Nealon United States Court-

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The United States courthouse located at ~~235~~ North
5 Washington Avenue in Scranton, Pennsylvania, shall be

1 designated and known as the “William J. Nealon United
2 States Courthouse”.

3 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

4 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
5 paper, or other record of the United States to the United
6 States courthouse referred to in section 1 shall be deemed
7 to be a reference to the “William J. Nealon United States
8 Courthouse”.

9 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

10 *The Federal building and United States courthouse lo-*
11 *cated at 235 North Washington Avenue in Scranton, Penn-*
12 *sylvania, shall be known and designated as the “William*
13 *J. Nealon Federal Building and United States Courthouse”.*

14 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

15 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
16 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
17 building and United States courthouse referred to in section
18 1 shall be deemed to be a reference to the “William J.
19 Nealon Federal Building and United States Courthouse”.

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill to designate
the Federal building and United States courthouse lo-
cated at 235 North Washington Avenue in Scranton,
Pennsylvania, as the ‘William J. Nealon Federal Building
and United States Courthouse’.”.
