A BILL

To amend the Clean Air Act to permit the exclusive application of State regulations regarding reformulated gas in certain areas.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. STATE REFORMULATED GAS RULES.**

4 Section 211(c)(4)(B) of the Clean Air Act is amended
5 by adding the following at the end thereof: “Whenever any
6 such State has promulgated reformulated gas rules for
7 any covered area (as defined in subsection (k)), such rules
8 shall apply in such area in lieu of the requirements of sub-
9 section (k) if such State rules will achieve equivalent or
10 greater reductions in emissions of ozone-forming com-

1 pounds and of toxic air contaminants than would result
2 from the application of the requirements of subsection
3 (k).”.
