## A BILL

To provide for payment under the Medicare program for transportation costs of portable ultrasound equipment for diagnostic tests in the same manner as payment is made for transportation costs of portable x-ray equipment.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. MEDICARE PAYMENT FOR TRANSPORTATION**  
2 **OF PORTABLE ULTRASOUND EQUIPMENT AS**  
3 **FOR TRANSPORTATION OF PORTABLE X-RAY**  
4 **EQUIPMENT.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Health and  
6 Human Services shall provide for payment under section  
7 1848 of the Social Security Act for the transportation of  
8 portable ultrasound equipment used in the furnishing of  
9 diagnostic tests under section 1861(s)(3) of such Act in  
10 the same manner as payment under section 1848 of such  
11 Act is made for the transportation of portable x-ray equip-  
12 ment used in the furnishing of diagnostic x-ray tests under  
13 such section 1861(s)(3).

14 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT FOR MEDICARE COV-  
15 ERAGE OF ULTRASOUND IN A HOME.—Section 1861(s)(3)  
16 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395x(s)(3)) is  
17 amended by inserting “and ultrasound” after “x-ray”.

18 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Subsection (a), and the  
19 amendment made by subsection (b), shall apply to  
20 ultrasound tests performed on or after the date of the en-  
21 actment of this Act.
