A BILL

To amend the Civil Rights Act of 1964 to protect first
amendment rights, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Women’s Right To
5 Know Act of 1995”.

6 **SEC. 2. FIRST AMENDMENT RIGHTS.**

7 Title XI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 is amended
8 by adding at the end the following:

9 “SEC. 1107. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision
10 of law, no governmental authority shall in or through any

1 program or activity, administered or assisted by such au-
2 thority, that provides health care services or information,
3 limit the right of any person to provide, or the right of
4 any person to receive, nonfraudulent information about
5 the availability of reproductive health care services, includ-
6 ing family planning, prenatal care, adoption, and abortion
7 services.

8 “(b) As used in this section—

9 “(1) the term ‘governmental authority’ means
10 any authority of any State or of the United States;
11 and

12 “(2) the term ‘State’ includes the District of
13 Columbia, Puerto Rico, and any other territory or
14 possession of the United States.”.
