## A BILL

To prohibit travel by Members, officers, and employees of the House of Representatives at lobbyist expense.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION OF TRAVEL BY MEMBERS, OFFI-**  
4 **CERS, AND EMPLOYEES OF THE HOUSE OF**  
5 **REPRESENTATIVES AT LOBBYIST EXPENSE.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—A Member, officer, or employee  
7 of the House of Representatives may not perform any  
8 travel at the expense of a person who is required to reg-  
9 ister under section 308 of the Federal Regulation of Lob-  
10 bying Act (2 U.S.C. 267).

1       (b) DEFINITION.—As used in this section, the term  
2 “Member of the House of Representatives” means a Rep-  
3 resentative in, or a Delegate or Resident Commissioner  
4 to, the Congress.
