Mr. DREIER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (S. 219) to improve the economy and efficiency of Federal Government operations by establishing a moratorium on regulatory rulemaking actions, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order, any rule of the House to the contrary
3 notwithstanding, to consider in the House a motion that
4 the House take from the Speaker's table the bill (S. 219)
5 to improve the economy and efficiency of Federal Govern-
6 ment operations by establishing a moratorium on regu-

1 latory rulemaking actions, and for other purposes, strike
2 all after the enacting clause of the Senate bill, and insert
3 the text of H.R. 450 as passed by the House. The motion
4 shall be debatable for one hour equally divided among and
5 controlled by the chairmen and ranking minority members
6 of the Committee on Government Reform and Oversight
7 and the Committee on the Judiciary. The previous ques-
8 tion shall be considered as ordered on the motion and on
9 the Senate bill to final passage without intervening motion
10 except one motion to commit.
