RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the joint resolution (H.J. Res. 108) making continuing appropriations for the fiscal year 1996, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order, any rule of the House to the contrary
3 notwithstanding, to consider in the House the joint resolu-
4 tion (H.J. Res. 108) making continuing appropriations for
5 the fiscal year 1996, and for other purposes. The joint
6 resolution shall be debatable for one hour equally divided
7 and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority

1 member of the Committee on Appropriations. The pre-
2 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the joint
3 resolution to final passage without intervening motion ex-
4 cept one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
5 The motion to recommit may include instructions only if
6 offered by the minority leader or his designee.
