# RESOLUTION

To provide to the Committee on Government Reform and Oversight special authorities to obtain testimony for purposes of investigation and study of the White House Travel Office matter.

1       *Resolved*, That—

2       (a) The Chairman of the Committee on Government  
3 Reform and Oversight, for purposes of the committee's in-  
4 vestigation and study of the White House Travel Office  
5 matter, may, upon consultation with the ranking minority  
6 member of the committee, authorize the taking of affida-  
7 vits, and of depositions pursuant to notice or subpoena,  
8 by a member or staff of the committee designated by the

1 chairman, or require the furnishing of information by in-  
2 terrogatory, under oath administered by a person other-  
3 wise authorized by law to administer oaths.

4 (b) Deposition and affidavit testimony, and informa-  
5 tion received by interrogatory, shall be deemed to have  
6 been taken in executive session of the committee in Wash-  
7 ington, District of Columbia. All deposition and affidavit  
8 testimony and information received by interrogatory shall  
9 be considered nonpublic until received by the committee,  
10 except that all such testimony and information shall, un-  
11 less otherwise directed by the committee, be available for  
12 use by members of the committee in open session of the  
13 committee.
