## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 125) to repeal the ban on semiautomatic assault weapons and the ban on large capacity ammunition feeding devices.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.  
3 125) to repeal the ban on semiautomatic assault weapons  
4 and the ban on large capacity ammunition feeding devices.  
5 The amendment printed in the report of the Committee  
6 on Rules accompanying this resolution shall be considered  
7 as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be debatable for

1 one hour equally divided and controlled by Representative  
2 Chapman of Texas or Representative Barr of Georgia and  
3 Representative Conyers of Michigan or his designee. The  
4 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the  
5 bill, as amended, to final passage without intervening mo-  
6 tion except one motion to recommit. The motion to recom-  
7 mit may include instructions only if offered by the minor-  
8 ity leader or his designee.
