Ms. GREENE of Utah, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3120) to amend title 18, United States Code, with respect to witness retaliation, witness tampering and jury tampering.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3120) to amend title 18, United
6 States Code, with respect to witness retaliation, witness

1 tampering and jury tampering. The first reading of the
2 bill shall be dispensed with. Points of order against consid-
3 eration of the bill for failure to comply with clause 7 of
4 rule XIII are waived. General debate shall be confined to
5 the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and
6 controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member
7 of the Committee on the Judiciary. After general debate
8 the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-
9 minute rule. It shall be in order to consider as an original
10 bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute
11 rule the amendment in the nature of a substitute rec-
12 ommended by the Committee on the Judiciary now printed
13 in the bill. The committee amendment in the nature of
14 a substitute shall be considered as read. During consider-
15 ation of the bill for amendment, the Chairman of the Com-
16 mittee of the Whole may accord priority in recognition on
17 the basis of whether the Member offering an amendment
18 has caused it to be printed in the portion of the Congres-
19 sional Record designated for that purpose in clause 6 of
20 rule XXIII. Amendments so printed shall be considered
21 as read. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for
22 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill
23 to the House with such amendments as may have been
24 adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote in the
25 House on any amendment adopted in the Committee of

1 the Whole to the bill or to the committee amendment in
2 the nature of a substitute. The previous question shall be
3 considered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto
4 to final passage without intervening motion except one
5 motion to recommit with or without instructions.
