Mr. SOLOMON submitted the following resolution; which was considered and agreed to

RESOLUTION

Fixing the daily hour of meeting for the One Hundred Fourth Congress.

1 *Resolved*, That unless otherwise ordered, the hour of
2 meeting of the House shall be 2 o'clock post meridiem on
3 Mondays; 11 o'clock ante meridiem on Tuesdays and
4 Wednesdays; and 10 o'clock ante meridiem on all other
5 days of the week up to and including May 13, 1995; and
6 that from May 15, 1995, until the end of the first session,
7 the hour of daily meeting of the House shall be noon on
8 Mondays and 10 o'clock ante meridiem on all other days
9 of the week.
