A BILL

To adjust and make uniform the dollar amounts used in title 18 to distinguish between grades of offenses, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Title 18 Uniformity
5 Act of 1995”.

6 **SEC. 2. ADJUSTING AND MAKING UNIFORM THE DOLLAR**
7 **AMOUNTS USED IN TITLE 18 TO DISTINGUISH**
8 **BETWEEN GRADES OF OFFENSES.**

9 (a) Sections 215, 288, 641, 643, 644, 645, 646, 647,
10 648, 649, 650, 651, 652, 653, 654, 655, 656, 657, 658,

1 659, 661, 662, 665, 872, 1003, 1025, 1163, 1361, 1707,
2 1711, and 2113 of title 18, United States Code, are
3 amended by striking “\$100” each place it appears and
4 inserting “\$1,000”.

5 (b) Section 510 of title 18, United States Code, is
6 amended by striking “\$500” and inserting “\$1,000”.

7 (c) Section 1864 of title 18, United States Code, is
8 amended by striking “\$10,000” and inserting “\$1,000”.
