A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of Agriculture to transfer funds to the farmers' market nutrition program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY TO TRANSFER FUNDS TO FARM-**
4 **ERS' MARKET NUTRITION PROGRAM.**

5 For fiscal year 1997, the Secretary of Agriculture
6 may transfer after consultation with the Appropriations
7 Committees of the House of Representatives and the Sen-
8 ate, from any funds available to the Secretary, up to
9 \$2,000,000 to the farmers' market nutrition program

1 under section 17(m) of the Child Nutrition Act of 1966
2 (42 U.S.C. 1786(m)). Amounts authorized to be trans-
3 ferred under the preceding sentence shall be in addition
4 to any amounts authorized to be made available to the
5 program under title IV of the Agriculture, Rural Develop-
6 ment, Food and Drug Administration, and related agen-
7 cies Appropriations Act, 1997 (110 Stat. 1590).
