Mr. BROWN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Rules and Administration

A BILL

To limit congressional terms.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TERM LIMITS.**

4 No person shall be elected to three consecutive terms
5 in the Senate. No person shall be elected to seven consecu-
6 tive terms in the House of Representatives.

7 **SEC. 2. PARTIAL TERMS.**

8 Election or appointment to a partial term shall not
9 count against the limitations of section 1.

1 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2 This Act shall apply to elections following the date
3 of enactment of this Act.
