1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE FOR PROJECT**
2 **NUMBER 4474.**

3 Notwithstanding the time limitations of section 13 of
4 the Federal Power Act, the Federal Energy Regulatory
5 Commission (referred to in this Act as the 'Commission'),
6 upon the request of the licensees for Commission Project
7 No. 4474, is authorized, in accordance with the good faith,
8 due diligence, and public interest requirements of section
9 13 of the Federal Power Act and the Commission's proce-
10 dures under such section, to extend until April 15, 2001,
11 the time required for the licensees to commence construc-
12 tion of such project.

13 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE FOR PROJECT NUMBER**
14 **7041.**

15 Notwithstanding the time limitations of section 13 of
16 the Federal Power Act, the Federal Energy Regulatory
17 Commission (referred to in this Act as the 'Commission'),
