A BILL

To terminate the Extremely Low Frequency Communication System of the Navy.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Extremely Low Fre-
5 quency Communication System Termination and Deficit
6 Reduction Act of 1995”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION OF FURTHER FUNDING OF THE EX-**
2 **TREMELY LOW FREQUENCY COMMUNICA-**
3 **TION SYSTEM.**

4 (a) PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS.—Except as
5 provided in subsection (b), funds appropriated on or after
6 the date of the enactment of this Act to or for the use
7 of the Department of Defense may not be obligated or ex-
8 pended for the Extremely Low Frequency Communication
9 System of the Navy.

10 (b) LIMITED EXCEPTION FOR TERMINATION
11 COSTS.—Subsection (a) does not apply to expenditures
12 solely for termination of the Extremely Low Frequency
13 Communication System.
