Mr. CRAIG introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred
to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Amalia Hatzipetrou and Konstantinos
Hatzipetrou.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

4 In the administration of the Immigration and Nation-
5 ality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 et seq.), Amalia Hatzipetrou and
6 Konstantinos Hatzipetrou shall be held and considered to
7 have been lawfully admitted to the United States for per-
8 manent residence as of the date of the enactment of this
9 Act upon payment of the required visa fees.

1 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

2 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Amalia
3 Hatzipetrou and Konstantinos Hatzipetrou as provided in
4 this Act, the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper
5 officer to reduce by one number during the current fiscal
6 year the total number of immigrant visas available to na-
7 tives of the country of the alien's birth under subsections
8 (a) and (b) of section 203 of the Immigration and Nation-
9 ality Act (8 U.S.C. 1153).
