## A BILL

To amend title VII of the Public Health Service Act to make certain graduate programs in clinical psychology eligible to participate in various health professions loan programs, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PARTICIPATION IN VARIOUS HEALTH PROFES-**  
4 **SIONS LOAN PROGRAMS.**

5 (a) LOAN AGREEMENTS.—Section 721 of the Public  
6 Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 292q) is amended—

7 (1) in subsection (a), by inserting “, or any  
8 public or nonprofit schools that offer graduate pro-

1       grams in clinical psychology” after “veterinary medi-  
2       cine”;

3           (2) in subsection (b)(4), by striking “or doctor  
4       of veterinary medicine or an equivalent degree” and  
5       inserting “doctor of veterinary medicine or an equiv-  
6       alent degree, or a graduate degree in clinical psy-  
7       chology”; and

8           (3) in subsection (c)(1), by inserting “, or  
9       schools that offer graduate programs in clinical psy-  
10      chology” after “veterinary medicine”.

11      (b) LOAN PROVISIONS.—Section 722 of such Act (42  
12      U.S.C. 292r) is amended—

13           (1) in subsection (b)(1), by striking “or doctor  
14      of veterinary medicine or an equivalent degree” and  
15      inserting “doctor of veterinary medicine or an equiv-  
16      alent degree, or a graduate degree in clinical psy-  
17      chology”; and

18           (2) in subsection (k)—

19                   (A) by striking “or podiatry” and inserting  
20                   “podiatry, or clinical psychology” in the matter  
21                   preceding paragraph (1); and

22                   (B) by striking “or podiatric medicine” in  
23                   paragraph (4), and inserting “podiatric medi-  
24                   cine, or clinical psychology”.
