A BILL

To direct the Senate and the House of Representatives to enact legislation on the budget for fiscal years 1996 through 2003 that would balance the budget by fiscal year 2003.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. BUDGET RESOLUTION FOR FISCAL YEARS 1996**
2 **THROUGH 2003.**

3 Not later than the end of the 1st session of the 104th
4 Congress, the Senate and House of Representatives
5 shall—

6 (1) adopt a concurrent resolution on the budget
7 for fiscal years 1996 through 2003; and

8 (2) enact all the necessary authorizing and ap-
9 propriations legislation,

10 that would balance the Federal budget by the beginning
11 of fiscal year 2003.
