## JOINT RESOLUTION

To provide for the appointment of Anne D'Harnoncourt as a citizen regent of the Board of Regents of the Smithsonian Institution.

1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2       *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That, in accordance with section 5581 of the Revised Stat-  
4       utes (20 U.S.C. 43), the vacancy on the Board of Regents  
5       of the Smithsonian Institution, in the class other than  
6       Members of Congress, occurring by reason of the expira-  
7       tion of the term of Samuel Curtis Johnson of Wisconsin  
8       on December 4, 1995, is filled by the appointment of Anne  
9       D'Harnoncourt of Pennsylvania. The appointment is for

1 a term of six years and shall take effect on December 5,
