## A BILL

To amend the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 to provide a limited overtime exemption for employees performing emergency medical services.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.**

4 Section 7(k) of the Fair Labor Standards Act of  
5 1938 (29 U.S.C. 207(k)) is amended in the matter before  
6 paragraph (1)—

7 (1) by striking “or any employee” and inserting  
8 “, any employee”, and

9 (2) by inserting before “if” the following: “, or  
10 any paramedic, emergency medical technician, or

1 rescue and ambulance service personnel trained to  
2 provide emergency medical services and to provide  
3 transport of persons receiving such services or trans-  
4 port of persons to receive such services”.
