Mr. BARR of Georgia introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To provide an exemption from the Gun-Free School Zones
Act of 1990 for conduct that does not violate State
or local law.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXEMPTION FROM THE GUN-FREE SCHOOL**
4 **ZONES ACT OF 1990 FOR CONDUCT THAT**
5 **DOES NOT VIOLATE STATE OR LOCAL LAW.**

6 (a) EXEMPTION FROM POSSESSION RESTRIC-
7 TIONS.—Section 922(q)(2)(B) of title 18, United States
8 Code, is amended—

9 (1) by striking “or” at the end of clause (vi);

1 (2) by striking the period at the end of clause
2 (vii) and inserting “; or”; and

3 (3) by adding at the end the following:

4 “(viii) if the possession does not violate the law
5 of the State or political subdivision in which the
6 school zone is located.”.

7 (b) EXEMPTION FROM DISCHARGE RESTRICTIONS.—

8 Section 922(q)(3)(B) of such title is amended—

9 (1) by striking “or” at the end of clause (iii);

10 (2) by striking the period at the end of clause
11 (iv) and inserting “; or”; and

12 (3) by adding at the end the following:

13 “(v) if the discharge does not violate the law of
14 the State or political subdivision in which the school
15 zone is located.”.
