## A BILL

To permit increased local management and control of Fullbright Park, a city park in the City of Union Gap, Washington, that was purchased in part with monies from the land and water conservation fund.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REMOVAL OF FEDERAL OVERSIGHT OF**  
4 **FULLBRIGHT PARK, CITY OF UNION GAP,**  
5 **WASHINGTON.**

6       (a) REMOVAL OF FEDERAL OVERSIGHT.—Subject to  
7 subsection (b), the Secretary of the Interior shall unilater-  
8 ally release all terms and conditions that were imposed

1 by the Secretary as a precondition on the contribution of  
2 monies from the land and water conservation fund for the  
3 acquisition and development of Fullbright Park in the City  
4 of Union Gap, Washington, a completed land and water  
5 conservation fund project owned and managed by the City.  
6 The Federal terms and conditions are contained as an at-  
7 tachment to the original December 1973 project contract  
8 between the City and the State of Washington entitled  
9 “South Park Acquisition” and given the project number  
10 74-002A.

11 (b) USE FOR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES.—The re-  
12 lease under subsection (a) shall be subject to the condition  
13 that the City agree to continue to use Fullbright Park to  
14 provide public recreation. This condition shall not be con-  
15 strued to require the City to obtain the consent of the Sec-  
16 retary regarding the types of recreational activities to be  
17 provided to the public at Fullbright Park or the manner  
18 in which recreational activities are provided.

19 (c) EFFECT ON TRIBAL RIGHTS.—The release under  
20 subsection (a) shall not affect any rights of the Yakama  
21 Indian Tribe with respect to the use of Fullbright Park.
