## A BILL

To designate the building in Orangeburg, South Carolina, which houses the operations of the United States Postal Service as the “J.I. Washington, III, Post Office”.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3 That the building in Orangeburg, South Carolina, which  
4 houses the operations of the United States Postal Service  
5 (as identified by the Postmaster General in writing) shall  
6 be known and designated as the “J.I. Washington, III,  
7 Post Office”, and any reference in a law, map, regulation,  
8 document, paper, or other record of the United States to

- 1 such building shall be deemed to be a reference to the
- 2 “J.I. Washington, III, Post Office”.
