A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Transportation to not require that the State of New Jersey repay Federal-aid highway funds expended on certain high occupancy vehicle lanes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That, notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Sec-
4 retary of Transportation shall not require the State of
5 New Jersey to repay any Federal-aid highway funds ex-
6 pended on construction of any high occupancy vehicle lane
7 or auxiliary lane on Interstate Route I-80 or I-287 within
8 the boundaries of the State if, before the State removes
9 a high occupancy vehicle restriction on such lane, the

- 1 State assures the Secretary, in writing, that removal of
- 2 such restriction is in the public interest.
