A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to allow a deduction for the cost of groceries purchased by employees and prepared into meals by employers for the convenience of employers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. COST OF GROCERIES PREPARED AS MEALS**

4 **FOR CONVENIENCE OF EMPLOYER.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 119 of the Internal Reve-
6 nue Code of 1986 (relating to meals or lodging furnished
7 for the convenience of the employer) is amended by adding
8 at the end the following new subsection:

1 “(e) GROCERIES PURCHASED BY EMPLOYEE AND
2 PREPARED INTO MEAL BY EMPLOYER.—For purposes of
3 subsection (a), the term ‘meal’ includes groceries pur-
4 chased by an employee and prepared by the employer.”.

5 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
6 subsection (a) shall apply to taxable years beginning after
7 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
