Mr. SAM JOHNSON of Texas (for himself and Mr. MURTHA) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Resources

A BILL

To authorize the Disabled Veterans' LIFE Memorial Foundation to establish a memorial in the District of Columbia or its environs to honor veterans who became disabled while serving in the Armed Forces of the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MEMORIAL TO HONOR DISABLED VETERANS**

4 **OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES.**

5 (a) MEMORIAL AUTHORIZED.—The Disabled Veter-
6 ans' LIFE Memorial Foundation is authorized to establish
7 a memorial on Federal land in the District of Columbia

1 or its environs to honor veterans who became disabled
2 while serving in the Armed Forces of the United States.

3 (b) COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARDS FOR COMMEMO-
4 RATIVE WORKS.—The establishment of the memorial shall
5 be in accordance with the Commemorative Works Act (40
6 U.S.C. 1001 et seq.).

7 (c) PAYMENT OF EXPENSES.—The Disabled Veter-
8 ans' LIFE Memorial Foundation shall be solely respon-
9 sible for acceptance of contributions for, and payment of
10 the expenses of, the establishment of the memorial. No
11 Federal funds may be used to pay any expense of the es-
12 tablishment of the memorial.

13 (d) DEPOSIT OF EXCESS FUNDS.—If, upon payment
14 of all expenses of the establishment of the memorial (in-
15 cluding the maintenance and preservation amount re-
16 quired under section 8(b) of the Commemorative Works
17 Act (40 U.S.C. 1008(b))), or upon expiration of the au-
18 thority for the memorial under section 10(b) of such Act
19 (40 U.S.C. 1010(b)), there remains a balance of funds re-
20 ceived for the establishment of the memorial, the Disabled
21 Veterans' LIFE Memorial Foundation shall transmit the
22 amount of the balance to the Secretary of the Treasury
23 for deposit in the account provided for in section 8(b)(1)
24 of such Act (40 U.S.C. 1008(b)(1)).
