## A BILL

To provide off-budget treatment for one-half of the receipts and disbursements of the land and water conservation fund.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3        **SECTION 1. OFF-BUDGET TREATMENT FOR ONE-HALF OF**  
4                                **THE RECEIPTS AND DISBURSEMENTS OF**  
5                                **LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND.**

6        Notwithstanding any other provision of law except  
7        the Line Item Veto Act of 1996, one-half of the receipts  
8        and disbursements of the receipts and disbursements of  
9        the land and water conservation fund—

1           (1) shall not be counted as new budget author-  
2           ity, outlays, receipts, or deficit or surplus for pur-  
3           poses of—

4                   (A) the budget of the United States Gov-  
5                   ernment as submitted by the President,

6                   (B) the congressional budget (including al-  
7                   locations of budget authority and outlays pro-  
8                   vided therein), or

9                   (C) the Balanced Budget and Emergency  
10                  Deficit Control Act of 1985; and

11           (2) shall be exempt from any general budget  
12           limitation imposed by statute on expenditures and  
13           net lending (budget outlays) of the United States  
14           Government.
