RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2646) to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to allow tax-free expenditures from education individual retirement accounts for elementary and secondary school expenses, to increase the maximum annual amount of contributions to such accounts, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of
3 order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 2646) to

1 amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to allow tax-
2 free expenditures from education individual retirement ac-
3 counts for elementary and secondary school expenses, to
4 increase the maximum annual amount of contributions to
5 such accounts, and for other purposes. The bill shall be
6 considered as read for amendment. The amendment in the
7 nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on
8 Ways and Means now printed in the bill, modified by the
9 amendment printed in part 1 of the report of the Commit-
10 tee on Rules accompanying this resolution, shall be consid-
11 ered as adopted. The previous question shall be considered
12 as ordered on the bill, as amended, and any further
13 amendment thereto to final passage without intervening
14 motion except: (1) one hour of debate on the bill, which
15 shall be equally divided and controlled by the chairman
16 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Ways
17 and Means; (2) the further amendment specified in part
18 2 of the report of the Committee on Rules, if offered by
19 Representative Rangel or his designee, which shall be in
20 order without intervention of any point of order or demand
21 for division of the question, shall be considered as read,
22 and shall be separately debatable for sixty minutes equally
23 divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent;
24 and (3) one motion to recommit with or without instruc-
25 tions.
