Mr. McINNIS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

---

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2493) to establish a mechanism by which the Secretary of Agriculture and the Secretary of the Interior can provide for uniform management of livestock grazing on Federal lands.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of  
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2493) to establish a mechanism

1 by which the Secretary of Agriculture and the Secretary  
2 of the Interior can provide for uniform management of  
3 livestock grazing on Federal lands. The first reading of  
4 the bill shall be dispensed with. General debate shall be  
5 confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour, with  
6 thirty minutes equally divided and controlled by the chair-  
7 man and ranking minority member of the Committee on  
8 Resources and thirty minutes equally divided and con-  
9 trolled by the chairman and ranking minority member of  
10 the Committee on Agriculture. After general debate the  
11 bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-  
12 minute rule for a period not to exceed three hours. It shall  
13 be in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose  
14 of amendment under the five-minute rule the amendment  
15 in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Commit-  
16 tee on Resources now printed in the bill. The committee  
17 amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be consid-  
18 ered as read. Before consideration of any other amend-  
19 ment it shall be in order to consider the amendment print-  
20 ed in the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying  
21 this resolution, if offered by Representative Smith of Or-  
22 egon or his designee. That amendment shall be considered  
23 as read, shall be debatable for ten minutes equally divided  
24 and controlled by the proponent and an opponent, and  
25 shall not be subject to a demand for division of the ques-

1 tion in the House or in the Committee of the Whole. If  
2 that amendment is adopted, the committee amendment in  
3 the nature of a substitute, as amended, shall be considered  
4 as the original bill for the purpose of further amendment.  
5 During consideration of the bill for further amendment,  
6 the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may accord  
7 priority in recognition on the basis of whether the Member  
8 offering an amendment has caused it to be printed in the  
9 portion of the Congressional Record designated for that  
10 purpose in clause 6 of rule XXIII. Amendments so printed  
11 shall be considered as read. The Chairman of the Commit-  
12 tee of the Whole may: (1) postpone until a time during  
13 further consideration in the Committee of the Whole a re-  
14 quest for a recorded vote on any amendment; and (2) re-  
15 duce to five minutes the minimum time for electronic vot-  
16 ing on any postponed question that follows another elec-  
17 tronic vote without intervening business, provided that the  
18 minimum time for electronic voting on the first in any se-  
19 ries of questions shall be fifteen minutes. At the conclusion  
20 of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee  
21 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such  
22 amendments as may have been adopted. Any Member may  
23 demand a separate vote in the House on any amendment  
24 adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to  
25 the amendment in the nature of a substitute made in order

1 as original text. The previous question shall be considered  
2 as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final  
3 passage without intervening motion except one motion to  
4 recommit with or without instructions.
