Mr. HASTINGS of Washington, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

---

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 992) to end the Tucker Act shuffle.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of  
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 992) to end the Tucker Act shuffle.  
6 The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. Gen-  
7 eral debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not ex-

1 ceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair-  
2 man and ranking minority member of the Committee on  
3 the Judiciary. After general debate the bill shall be consid-  
4 ered for amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall  
5 be in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose  
6 of amendment under the five-minute rule the amendment  
7 in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Commit-  
8 tee on the Judiciary now printed in the bill. The committee  
9 amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be consid-  
10 ered as read. During consideration of the bill for amend-  
11 ment, the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may  
12 accord priority in recognition on the basis of whether the  
13 Member offering an amendment has caused it to be print-  
14 ed in the portion of the Congressional Record designated  
15 for that purpose in clause 6 of rule XXIII. Amendments  
16 so printed shall be considered as read. The Chairman of  
17 the Committee of the Whole may: (1) postpone until a  
18 time during further consideration in the Committee of the  
19 Whole a request for a recorded vote on any amendment;  
20 and (2) reduce to five minutes the minimum time for elec-  
21 tronic voting on any postponed question that follows an-  
22 other electronic vote without intervening business, pro-  
23 vided that the minimum time for electronic voting on the  
24 first in any series of questions shall be fifteen minutes.  
25 At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amend-

1 ment the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the  
2 House with such amendments as may have been adopted.  
3 Any Member may demand a separate vote in the House  
4 on any amendment adopted in the Committee of the Whole  
5 to the bill or to the committee amendment in the nature  
6 of a substitute. The previous question shall be considered  
7 as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final  
8 passage without intervening motion except one motion to  
9 recommit with or without instructions.
