Mr. DIAZ-BALART, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3248) to provide dollars to the classroom.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3248) to provide dollars to the
6 classroom. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed
7 with. General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall

1 not exceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the
2 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee
3 on Education and the Workforce. After general debate the
4 bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-
5 minute rule. It shall be in order to consider as an original
6 bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute
7 rule the amendment in the nature of a substitute rec-
8 ommended by the Committee on Education and the Work-
9 force now printed in the bill. The committee amendment
10 in the nature of a substitute shall be considered as read.
11 Points of order against the committee in the nature of
12 a substitute for failure to comply with clause 7 of rule
13 XVI are waived. No amendment to the committee amend-
14 ment in the nature of a substitute shall be in order except
15 those printed in the report of the Committee on Rules ac-
16 companying this resolution. Each amendment may be of-
17 fered only in the order printed in the report, may be of-
18 fered only by a Member designated in the report, shall
19 be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time spec-
20 ified in the report equally divided and controlled by the
21 proponent and an opponent, and shall not be subject to
22 amendment. The chairman of the Committee of the Whole
23 may: (1) postpone until a time during further consider-
24 ation in the Committee of the Whole a request for a re-
25 corded vote on any amendment; and (2) reduce to five

1 minutes the minimum time for electronic voting on any
2 postponed question that follows another electronic vote
3 without intervening business, provided that the minimum
4 time for electronic voting on the first in any series of ques-
5 tions shall be 15 minutes. At the conclusion of consider-
6 ation of the bill for amendments the Committee shall rise
7 and report the bill to the House with such amendments
8 as may have been adopted. Any Member may demand a
9 separate vote in the House on any amendment adopted
10 in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to the commit-
11 tee amendment in the nature of a substitute. The previous
12 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
13 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
14 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
15 structions.
