Mr. CONDIT (for himself, Mr. DEUTSCH, and Mr. LAHOOD) submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Ordering the immediate printing of the entire communication received on September 9, 1998, from an independent counsel.

Whereas the entire communication of the Office of the Independent Counsel received by the House of Representatives on September 9, 1998, includes information of fundamental constitutional importance;

Whereas the American people have a right to receive and review this communication in its entirety;

Whereas the House Committee on the Judiciary has failed to make the entire communication available to the American people; and

Whereas failure to make the entire communication available to the American people raises a question of privilege affecting the dignity and integrity of the proceedings of the

House under rule IX of the Rules of the House of Representatives: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the entire communication received, in-
2 cluding all appendices and related materials, on Septem-
3 ber 9, 1998, from an independent counsel, pursuant to
4 section 595(c) of title 28, United States Code, shall be
5 printed immediately as a document of the House of Rep-
6 resentatives.
